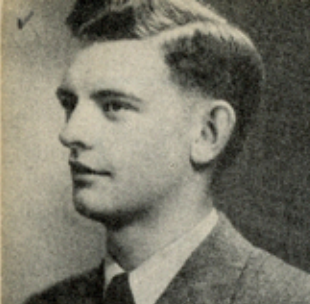
Elected in mid-October by the Grade Twelve student body, the Grade Twelve Executive consists of six students whose duties are to arrange the Grads' school social activities.
