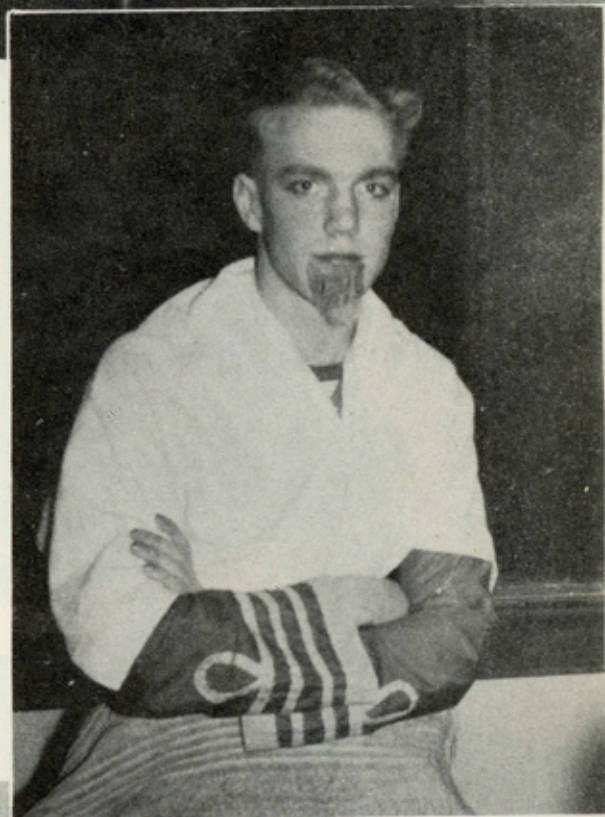


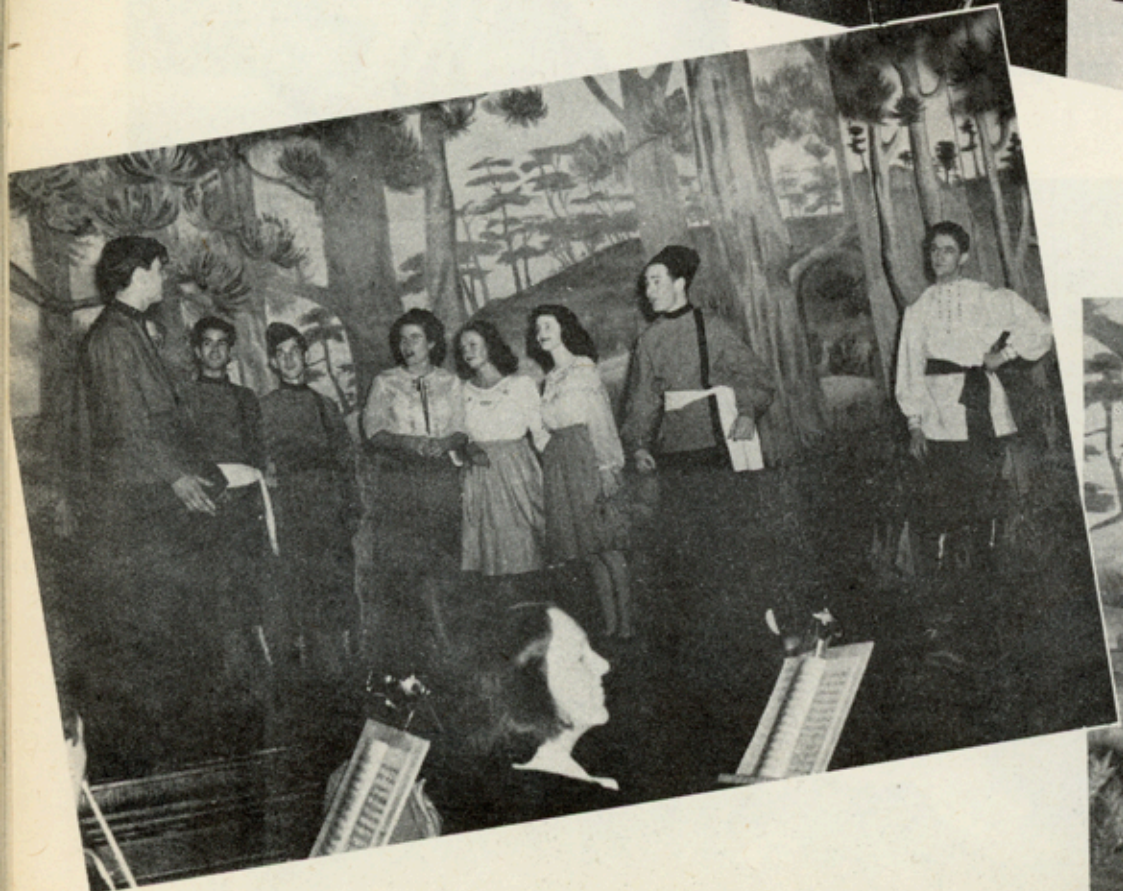
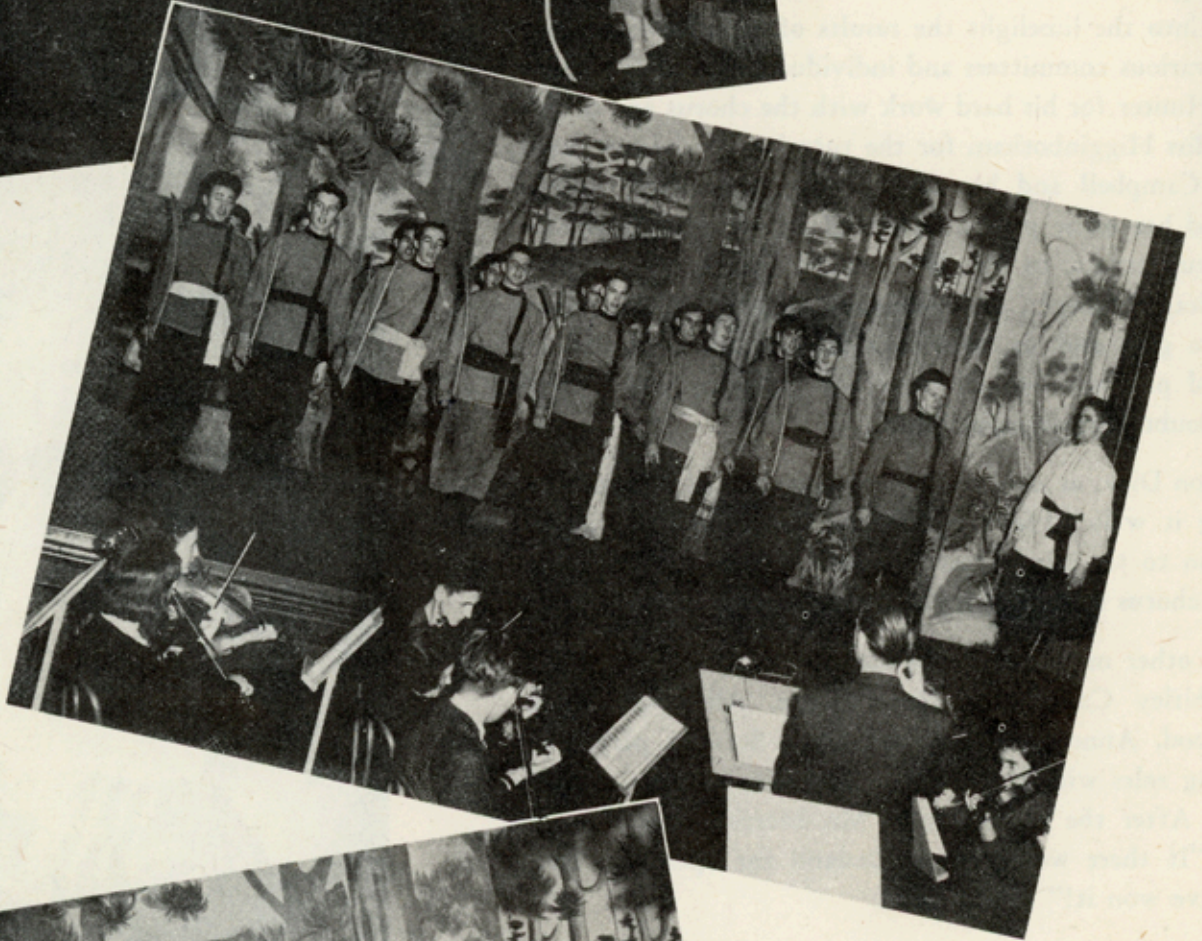
OPERETTA
